Come to the Zabłocie Space CLUSTER

The idea of the Socio-Economic Innovation Cluster Zabłocie 20.22 was born during public consultations held under the Municipal Programme for the Revitalisation of Kraków back in 2016.

The cluster was established in former warehouses, in a former industrial area of the city. In 2022, a shared workspace for start-ups, entrepreneurs, non-governmental organisations, artistic circles, and residents was opened. Since then, the cluster has been rapidly developing the facilities it offers; meetings, workshops and conferences are held for the sharing of experience and cooperation between people from various sectors.

The last quarter of 2023 saw sixteen events and meetings on various topics, with over 870 parti-

cipants. Furthermore, Building A now houses institutions including the Food Bank, the Social Integration Centre, and the Multicultural Centre, which are organisations well matched to the objectives of the cluster, aimed at creating conditions which aid the development of social entrepreneurship, integration of local business operations, and support of social integration.

From 12 to 15 March 2024, Kraków once more presented its investment potential during the MIPIM international real estate and property development fair in Cannes, France. As previously, in promoting our city, we focused on large strategic projects: "Kraków Nowa Huta Przyszłości," "Kraków Airport" and "Wesoła."

Urban residential and business estate projects also caught attention at the fair. The Kraków stand was visited by representatives of several dozen companies and institutions, and the Kraków delegation went to 65 meetings. Our city was once more acknowledged for its efforts to attract investors. During the fair, Kraków was recognised numerous times in the European Cities & Regions of the Future 2024 ranking, organised by the prestigious fDi Magazine.

The future of education at the NEW EDUCATION FORUM

In the scheme "New Education Forum Kraków 2024," the City of Kraków and the Innovative Education Centre organised an event titled "Paths to Tomorrow: Education of conscious citizens, artificial intelligence, and shaping career horizons" ("Ścieżki do jutra: Edukacja świadomych obywateli, sztuczna inteligencja i kształtowanie horyzontów kariery"). Engaging workshops and discussion panels brought to Kraków close to 200 people interested in issues of modern education.

The New Education Forum (NEF) is a platform for people to share knowledge, experiences and contacts in vocational education and training, the labour market, open-air education, and any and all innovative methodologies in education.

- "Ever since its establishment in 2015, the NEF has aimed at fostering effective cooperation between the regions of the EU and European institutions on the education of the future," said Joanna Bochniarz, President of the Innovative Education Centre Foundation.

- "The New Education Forum, organised in Kraków for the first time, addresses the needs of a dynamically changing reality. Kraków is the perfect place for a discussion on the needs and challenges of education. The impact of artificial intelligence on the learning process, economic education at school from an early age, and new professions – these are just some examples of the topics we will discuss in Kraków," said Jacek Majchrowski, Mayor of Kraków, in his invitation.

At NEF Kraków 2024, workshops were held for teachers at the Socio-Economic Innovation Cluster Zabłocie 20.22 and the Kraków Economic Salon of the National Bank of Poland. In turn, during discussion panels and presentations held at the Meeting Room of the Kraków City Council, experts touched upon issues of integrating economic education at schools, the innovative role of artificial intelligence in shaping learning environments, and the impact that Al has on labour markets and career paths. WOMEN'S CAREERS – an event at the Zabłocie Space Cluster

The special day of 29 February 2024 saw the Socio-Economic Innovation Cluster Zabłocie host "Women's Careers" ("Kariera Kobiet"), an event organised jointly by the Department of Entrepreneurship and Innovation at the Kraków City Hall and the Municipal Labour Office in Kraków.

The event was addressed to all women – those professionally active, who are working or running a business, but also those looking for a job or considering a career change.

During the opening ceremony, the Plenipotentiary for Equality Policy, Ms Nina Gabryś-Janowska, presented her "projekt #krakowianki" a project aimed at raising awareness of the unique role of women in the development of the city and their influence on its social, artistic, economic and scientific transformations. Various measures are implemented under this project, including the creation of the Kazimiera Bujwidowa Prize for eminent women from Kraków; "Entrepreneurial women from Kraków" ("Przedsiębiorcze krakowianki"), a programme to strengthen the position of women in the labour market; "Champions" ("Mistrzynie"), a campaign supporting sportswomen; the organisation of the "Kraków Women Month" and the establishment of

a tourist trail devoted to the city's heroines. Ms Barbara Man, representing the Mamo Pracuj Foundation, encouraged women to boldly take the entrepreneurial path and cited the findings of the 2022 Report on the Professional Situation of Women, which states that close to half of the women surveyed were thinking of switching industries or making a career change, with setting up one's own business being one of the possible options. That is why the motto "Grab the steering wheel - set your course reach your destination" confirms that courage and belief in one's own abilities are the most important things in pursuing one's objectives, and that true change begins the moment the decision to change is made.

The event was met with considerable interest among Kraków women. We therefore wish all the participants of **"Women's Careers"** good luck and all the best in their professional journey!

DIGITAL DRAGONS 2024 – the May feast of the video game industry

Organised by the Kraków Technology Park, the Digital Dragons 2024 conference is the next instalment of one of the largest B2B events for the video game industry in Europe. From 19 to 21 May, the three-day celebration of gamedev will, as is the tradition, attract video game developers, artists, publishers and investors as well as top video game journalists from across the world. The previous Digital Dragons event saw a record turnout, with over 2,500 people associated with the video game industry coming to the capital of Lesser Poland. Digital Dragons Awards: during an official ceremony, Digital Dragon statuettes will be awarded for the best Polish video games of the past year.

An appealing programme: at the heart of the Digital Dragons 2024 conference are specialist talks given at the ICE Kraków Congress Centre. Speakers include Borislav Slavov, who composed the soundtrack to the hit Baldur's Gate 3; Jason Hickey, Art Director and producer of shows such as the Marvel's Spider-Man series; and a duo from EA Dice – Nika J. Bender and Kevin Moore – who will talk about developing the life service for Battlefield 2042.

Digital Dragons 2024 is also a forum for discussion on the most important industry topics. The topics on the agenda include those related to employment rights. **Indie games:** a special exhibition space will be made available for independent developers, who will be able to present their games to the media, as well as potential investors and publishers.

Digital Dragons Hub: the conference is only one of the elements of the Digital Dragons ecosystem which the Kraków Technology Park has prepared for the gamedev industry. It also covers incubation and acceleration programmes for indie developers, as well as educational programmes, including the Digital Dragons Academy for students of higher education institutions.


